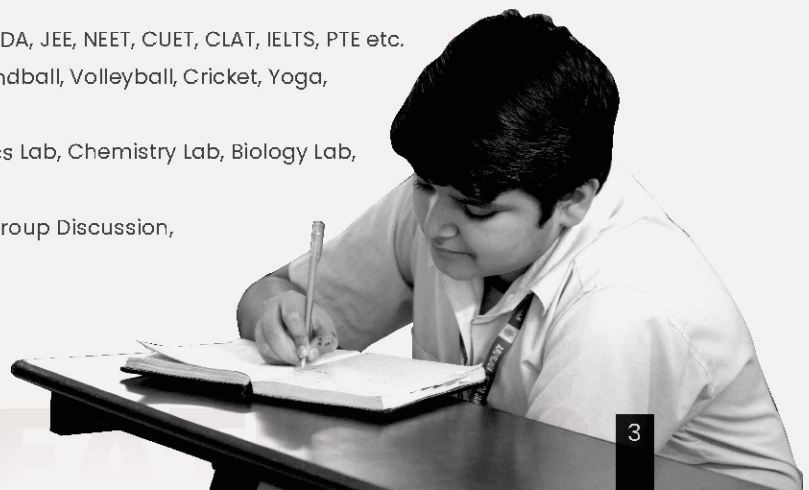

विद्यालय के नियम

1. सभी छात्रों व अभिभावक विद्यालय के अनुशासन को बनाए रखने के लिए अपने को विद्यालय के समय समय पर बनने वाले नियमों व नियमावली से अवगत रखें।
2. विद्यालय व बोर्ड की परीक्षा का पात्र होने के लिए सभी छात्रों के लिए प्रत्येक विषय में 75% उपस्थिति होना अनिवार्य है।
3. बच्चों के सर्वांगीण विकास के लिए अभिभावकों एवं अध्यापकों में सहयोग आवश्यक है। अभिभावक बच्चों की डायरी अवश्य देखें तथा उन्हें विकासोन्मुख बनाए रखने के लिए प्रोत्साहित व पथ प्रदर्शन करते रहें।
4. यदि कोई छात्र अनुशासनहीनता, दुर्यवहार, चोरी, विद्यालय सम्पत्ति को नुकसान पहुँचाना, बिना अनुमति के चले जाना, परीक्षा में नकल करने आदि की दोषी पायी जाती है तो उस छात्र के खिलाफ सख्त कार्यवाही की जाएगी, जिसमें आर्थिक दंड व निष्कासन भी शामिल है।
5. छात्रों को विद्यालय में नकद राशि रखने की अनुमति नहीं है। सभी छात्रों के स्कूल कैटीन खर्चों के लिए एक अलग अकाउंट बना होता है जिसमें अभिभावक जरूरत अनुसार धनराशि जमा करवाएँ। छात्रा कैटीन से सामान लेने के लिए कैटीन स्लिप का इस्तेमाल करते हैं जिस पर अभिभावक या हाउसमास्टर/सहायक हाउसमास्टर / हॉस्टल सुपरवाइजर के हस्ताक्षर होने अनिवार्य है। कैटीन स्लिप के अनुसार छात्र के कैटीन अकाउंट से धन निकाल लिया जाता है। अभिभावक अकाउंट ऑफिस से किसी भी समय इस विषय में पड़ताल कर हिसाब देख सकते हैं।
6. छात्र प्रतिदिन स्कूल डायरी में हर विषय का मिला हुआ गृह कार्य लिखेगा जिस पर प्रतिदिन अभिभावक या सहायक हाउस मास्टर के हस्ताक्षर होना अनिवार्य है। अभिभावक भी इस बात का ध्यान करें कि बच्चा गृह कार्य नियमित रूप से करे।
7. स्कूल डायरी या पहचान पत्र खो जाने की स्थिति में पुनः बनवाने के लिए 300 रुपए का शुल्क लगेगा।
8. विद्यालय में किसी भी छात्र को अपने पास धनराशि, मोबाइल फोन या कोई अन्य इलेक्ट्रॉनिक डिवाइस, गहने या कोई अन्य मूलावान बस्तु लाने व रखने की अनुमति नहीं है। इस नियम की अवहेलना करने की स्थिति में निषेध वस्तु जब्त कर ली जाएगी और छात्र के खिलाफ सख्त कार्यवाही की जाएगी, जिसमें आर्थिक दंड व निष्काशन भी शामिल है।
9. परीक्षाओं के समय में किसी भी छात्र को कोई अवकाश नहीं मिलेगा। परीक्षा से अनुपस्थित होने की स्थिति में परीक्षा पुनः नहीं ली जाएगी।
10. ग्रीष्मावकाश से पहले व निर्धारित **PTM** के दिन कक्षाचार्या से अवश्य मिलें और यूनिट टेस्ट के नतीजों, रिपोर्ट कार्ड व छात्र के निरंतर विकास की जानकारी अवश्य लें।
11. कोई भी छात्र या छात्रा, प्राचार्या द्वारा लिखित अनुमति के बिना विद्यालय से अनुपस्थित ना रहे। ऐसा करने से छात्र/छात्रा की पढ़ाई का नुकसान होगा और अभिभावक को 100 रुपए प्रतिदिन उपेक्षा शुल्क देना होगा।
12. अभिभावकों को केवल पहचान पत्र द्वारा ही स्कूल में प्रवेश एवं छात्र/छात्रा से मिलने की अनुमति दी जाएगी। कृपया दाखिले के तुरंत बाद ही पहचान पत्र बनवाएँ।

छात्रावास के नियम

1. छात्र एक सत्र में 7 दिन तक का अवकाश ले सकता है। अवकाश लेने के लिए प्राचार्या जी से पूर्व अनुमति लेना आवश्यक है। इस अवकाश को गर्मी, दिवाली या सर्दी के अवकाश के साथ जोड़ा नहीं जा सकता है।
2. छात्रावास में सेवा के माध्यम से छात्र विद्यालय के कार्यों में योगदान करते हैं। इस प्रक्रिया में भाग लेना सभी के लिए अनिवार्य है।
3. छात्रों के माता पिता / अभिभावकों को निर्धारित दिनों पर ही छात्रों को मिलने की अनुमति होगी।
4. अभिभावक केवल स्वागत कक्ष में ही आ सकते हैं। छात्रावास के अंदर जाने की अनुमति नहीं होगी।
5. नये छात्रों को पहले 14 दिनों तक अभिभावक से बात करने या मिलने की अनुमति नहीं होगी। नई छात्रों के अभिभावकों को हाउसमास्टर द्वारा समय-समय पर छात्र के हाल और व्यवहार का समाचार दिया जाएगा। यह प्रक्रिया नई छात्रों को छात्रावास के वातावरण में ढालने के लिए अनिवार्य होती है।
6. विद्यालय परिसर में डिस्पेन्सरी में इलाज निशुल्क है पर बाहर किसी अन्य अस्पताल में इलाज के लिए शुल्क अलग से देय होगा।
7. गर्मी, दिवाली या सर्दी के अवकाश के अलावा, किसी अन्य कारण से, 4 से ज्यादा दिन के अवकाश पर जाने की स्थिति में छात्रों को अपना सारा सामान वलॉक रूम में जमा करवाना होगा।
8. अभिभावक कृपया अवकाश की तारीख के अनुसार ही अपने बच्चे को लेने के लिए आएं। समय से पहले ले जाने की अनुमति नहीं होगी। बिना अनुमति के अवकाश अवधि से पहले जाने या देर से आने पर अभिभावक को 500 रुपये प्रतिदिन की दर से उपेक्षा शुल्क देना होगा।
9. अभिभावक कृपया अवकाश की तारीख के अनुसार ही अपने बच्चे को लेने के लिए आएं। समय से पहले ले जाने की अनुमति नहीं होगी।
10. विद्यालय छात्रावास में रहने वाले छात्रों के माता पिता / अभिभावक सहित चार व्यक्तियों को केवल पहचान पत्र के साथ ही मिलने की अनुमति होगी।
11. छात्रावास में किसी भी तेजधार वस्तु जैसे कैची, ब्लेड, चाकू रखना वर्जित है।

- Parents can meet their ward only on the first Sunday of every month if you visit them frequently your child would not adjust in the School environment. Parents are not allowed to their ward or any teacher in the school time otherwise he will be charged a fine of Rs. 500.
- It is strictly prohibited to provide students with edible items fried or roasted in Ghee or Oil. Parents are advised not to provide them the above.
- Deposit the quarterly charges of fee and other expenses on due date so that you can avoid late fee. No reminder will be sent in this regard.
- Your ward should not be absent for a single day when summer and winter break is over because he suffers a lot in his studies as well as he has to pay a fine of Rs. 1000 and Rs. 200 for coming late.
- All students and their parents should keep the manual of instructions with them to maintain discipline at KIS Karnal. Parents are allowed to communicate with their wards only on Sunday from 7:00 am to 6.00 pm only if any emergency occurs.
- Due to students' being busy in daily schedule it is not possible for parents to communicate with their wards on any day except for Sundays. Anyhow they can convey their message through Chief Warden/Reception.
- A Student will not be allowed to attend any marriage or any other ceremony during exam days. There will be no re-examination for students who don't appear in quarterly exam.
- Parents should take away luggage of their ward within five days in case his name is struck off the school rolls. KIS Karnal will not be responsible in this regard.
- Student seeking admission in KIS Karnal must be physically fit and free from contagious/communicable disease.
- If a student is unable to submit his Transfer Certificate up to 30th April his admission will be cancelled.
- For any issue related to student, please contact to his Warden or Chief Warden.
- Parents/Guardians must accompany their ward at the time of admission, summer vacations, winter vacations and also while dropping in school after vacations.

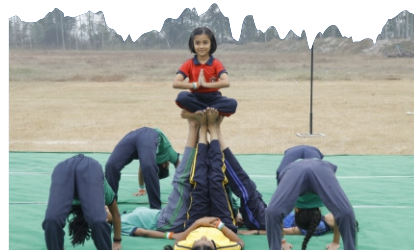




